Are you ready to consume amazingly fresh, local produce? Well then let's get this boring part of the process out of the way! By signing up for a 2016 CSA membership, you inherently agree to the following terms and conditions.

Seasonal Vegetables

The nature of a CSA program is that you, the consumer, eat with the season. This means that as different crops become ready to harvest, that's what you receive in your weekly box. This may include strange vegetables like kohlrabi or turnips. If you despise kohlrabi (we have yet to meet someone who does), we'll do our best to replace it with something else. But we CANNOT guarantee this will be possible.

Imperfections

Real produce is not always perfect. Sometimes your produce will suffer from bruises, nicks, scratches, or it might even be hosting a small passenger. We'll do our darndest to make sure you're getting the best of the best, but please don't expect the perfectly glossy produce you get at your big-box grocery store.

Disasters

In farming, disasters are sometimes inevitable. Drought, floods, pests, diseases, farmer death...the list goes on. By using permaculture practices on our farm, we mitigate many of these issues, but we're certainly not immune to the forces of nature. By committing to a CSA membership, you assume the risk that we may not be able to fulfill your order if disaster strikes. You can rest assured we'll do everything in our Jedi-like farmer powers to prevent this situation!

Pick-up/Delivery

We offer three convenient methods of pick-up/delivery. You can pick-up at our Ottawa location on Wednesday or our North Gower location on Saturday, or we can deliver to your door on Saturday for an extra cost. Please note there will be no other options for pick-up or delivery, so please don't expect to receive produce any other day than the one you specify when purchasing your membership.
